Please note: **All recertification periods for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA), Temporary Disability Assistance Program (TDAP), or Public Assistance to Adults (PAA) due in the months of October 2020 through March 2021 have been postponed to a later date. See flyers attached for additional information.**

On December 19, 2020, **Governor Larry Hogan announced that additional funding has been made available to the TCA program.** Effective January 1, 2021, through June 30, 2021, each active TCA household will receive a monthly amount of \$100 for each active household member in addition to the household’s regular benefit amount. This action will be done automatically.

**As provided in the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021, the maximum SNAP benefits will increase by 115% of the June 2020 amount.** This increase will remain in effect each month from January 1, 2021 until June 30, 2021. Below, please find the chart with the new maximum SNAP allotment for Maryland effective January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021.
